GOALS //

The overarching goal of Child360's two-year study was to explore the viability and costeffectiveness of online coaching via TORSH Talent in order to address four organizational goals:

Increase Reach

Expand access to coaching supports, including access for geographically hard-to-reach programs



More Affordable

Determine if adoption of an online platform results in measurable cost savings to coaching providers

Increase Coaching Dosage

Increase the amount of coaching time that was available to the teachers supported by Child360

Maintain Quality

Provide teachers with a high-quality coaching experience while retaining the core principles of their in-person model
